A Resolution to authorize the Mayor to execute an Amendment No. 1 to the three-year Vendor Agreement, entered into on January 29, 2024, pursuant to §11-40-1 and §11-43-55 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, with LiveView Technologies, Inc. ("LVT"), for LVT to provide the City Police Department *(BPD) with two 03 Live Units, for a total of Two Hundred Seven Thousand Four Hundred Eighty and 00/100 Dollars (\$207,480.24). This Amendment No. 1 adds three additional 03 Live Units to the City, which includes, but is not limited to: (1) two subscriptions - Smart Generator; (2) two Mobile Mount- Solar-Gen; (3) Setup: and (4) Shipping: for an additional cost of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Seven Hundred Five and 29/100 Dollars (\$250,705.29). The Mayor is further authorized to spend up to an additional \$10,000.00/year to cover relocation and data expenses. The total amount to be expended shall not exceed Four Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand One Hundred Eighty-five and 53/00 Dollars (\$488,185.53).

Birmingham Police Department Report

44 calls during the past 6 months for service; ranging from assaults, weapon violations, fights (12), 12-Signal 99 calls, 3 homicides/1 officer injured (in the past three years), unsecured entry points/customers not being screened at entrance, inadequate safety plan. It appears that repeat offenders are still allowed to enter the establishment (poor entry points).
